In early 2026, Inclusive Minds Foundation officially began delivering services, marking the realization of the groundwork laid in 2025.

Clinician Services

We are now actively connecting clients with coaching, therapy, and assessment services through licensed clinicians, offering support that is professional, specialized, and grounded in inclusivity.

Reduced Fee Program

Our reduced fee program is now being implemented, helping ensure that cost is not a barrier to receiving care.
